You will be surprised to receive this short letter from a brother in Jesus Christ, in the one and only priesthood. I recently read in your paper the third condemnation by Cardinal Ouellet.


Now, what are you doing about it? Permit me to probe your fidelity to the Church. FOR WHOM AND BY WHOM DID YOU ACCEPT ORDINATION TO THE PRIESTHOOD? Did you accept the priestly ordination from the Church of Christ, through a bishop of that Church, or from Marie-Paule for Marie-Paule? Yes, you have to ask yourself the real question. By WHOM AND FOR WHOM ARE YOU PRIESTS? MAKE THE CHOICE. If you were to die tomorrow morning what would Jesus say to you? What would be your reply? That you were one with the Vine of the Lord, or a branch cut off?

I know all of you, for I was somewhat your spiritual father for 14 years. I was appointed Father of the Family of the Sons and Daughters of Mary in 1981, and there was an abundance of vocations, up until my rejection by Marie-Paule, and then the vocations fell off. I was rejected because I refused to teach the heresy for which you are presently being condemned. Michel Palud and Dupuis also had to make the choice, and it was their DUTY to remain faithful to the Catholic Church that IS ONE, HOLY, CATHOLIC AND APOSTOLIC. According to our CREDO.

It is up to each of you to respond in accordance with his conscience. You made a VOW of fidelity to the bishop who ordained you. And you made the vows of religion. Now a vow obliges in conscience. It is up to each one to respond, not to me, but before God. I am writing to hold out my hand and to give you help if you want it. Come and visit me as a friend and confrere in the priesthood, for I have always liked you and still like you. I am the chaplain of a new community that pays obedience to our bishop, Archbishop André Gaumond, Archbishop of Sherbrooke, a good friend and confrere while we were at Saint Paul's Seminary in Ottawa. Archbishop Gaumond is very kind and will open the door to you, if you ask this. We will be able to help you.

Dear confrere in the priesthood, I know that you love your priesthood. Don't waste your time. Jesus is opening His arms to you, is giving you another chance. With love for Jesus respond with love for the glory of God and souls.
