

## LETTER FROM SUZANNE AND BERTRAND DESBIENS

Quebec, June 13, 2005

Dear Marie-Paule,

In this period that marks a turning point for the Work of the Co-Redemption and for the Church, we would like to repeat to you all our love and our support in the face of the assaults of the adversary. We have very little to offer other than our poor prayers. And they are so very small, but so very necessary to keep us faithful.

The answers given to those who attack are of a great richness and beauty. They will not change the way of seeing things for those who do not want to see, but they have the merit of defending in a luminous manner the Lady's Work and of maintaining the truth. Over the last few weeks, we have had the impression of reliving, in a very succinct and brief period, the 33 years of the Army of Mary. Always the same incomprehension born of the same blindness.

The testimonials of Marc Bosquart, Yvan Laprise, Sylvie Payeur-Raynauld, Father Pierre Mastropietro and others are edifying and stimulating. Everything is clear and simple, while the adversaries have so very little to say because they have not wanted to approach the Mystery of this time with humility. But their obscurantism must serve as a great lesson for all of us. When Heaven manifests itself, we must approach this presence by plunging ourselves into an abyss of humility because God confounds the proud. *Life of Love* gives numerous examples of this. Therefore, let us pray for them; let us pray that the scales may fall from their eyes. Let us love as the Redeemer and the Co-Redemptrix have taught us to love.
