Remember, Your Excellency, that Jesus said: *“I was away from home and you gave me no welcome.”* (Mt 25:43)

As far as I am concerned, and this since 1983, she has not given me that impression. Marie-Paule has made it possible for me to advance along the way of the Lord through her *Life of Love*; she has brought me to love those who wanted to harm me; she has transformed me through that wonderful interior reform. Without the Army of Mary, and thus without Marie-Paule, I would never have been able to keep the faith and to bear it there where it is leading me today.

And do you know where it is leading me? To FORGIVENESS – to LOVE – to SELF-ABANDONMENT!

To forgiveness for you and for our enemies.

To love for all and forever.

To self-abandonment to the love of God, for nothing bad will ever happen to me.

Finally, Your Excellency, why has it taken so long? Have not the Sons of Mary been present in your diocese for almost 17 years? Why did you have to taste the good fruit for 17 years and then decide to throw out the tree only today?

Marie-Paule is the greatest gift heaven could ever have sent me. I regret that you do not want to accept it for yourself as well.
