

*“Woe to you scribes and Pharisees, you frauds! You shut the doors of the kingdom of God in men’s faces, neither entering yourselves nor admitting those who are trying to enter.” (Mt 23:13)*

These words addressed to the scribes and Pharisees were most certainly difficult to swallow by those who were relentlessly striving to silence Christ and to turn the Jewish people away from His teaching. Should these words be applied, today, to the adversaries of the Work of the Lady of All Peoples who are attempting to close the terrestrial Kingdom to men? I would hope not. After so many prayers and supplications addressed to our Father in heaven so that His Kingdom may come on earth as it is in heaven, are we going to reject the grace He is granting us in this time chosen by Him, on the simple request made by those who should rejoice over the fact that God is finally granting the prayer of His Church?

The adversaries of the Lady can do all they want to try to close what God has opened, but I continue to place my trust in the Lady who promised victory, making my own the words of Pope John Paul II which were taken up again by Pope Benedict XVI – *“Do not be afraid”* –, and I add: to believe in the Work of the Co-Redemption, this *Life of Love* lived and accomplished by Mother Paul-Marie on behalf of Mary Immaculate, Mother and Lady of All Peoples.

May the adversaries of the Work of God who do not seem to or do not want to understand the Work offered to all peoples so that they may be preserved from corruption, disaster and war, become aware that they are not standing up to a work of human volition but to a Work of divine volition.
