

“A Few Cyrenians Will Support You....”

Dear Marie-Paule,

I have just read issue no. 174 (July-August) of *Le Royaume*. My soul is filled with light and my heart with love and joy. The same is true for Father Stéphane. What a frank and luminous plea for the defence of the Army of Mary and its humble Foundress!... Every article is replete with truth, light, charity and respect....

All the points of contention have been touched upon and made clear, thanks to the unanimous collaboration of the Sons and Daughters of Mary. I would like to pause and discourse on each article, but there would be no end...

Sister Yolande Riberdy was not afraid to say to the Pontifical Commissioner, “*My silence would be cowardice... May the Holy Spirit open your mind and your heart to an understanding of the Mystery of the Co-Redemption.*”

Father Eric Roy humbly reminded the Commissioner that the Sons of Mary have the right

to act according to their conscience with regard to the Work....

The letter that struck me the most was Nicole Glover’s letter to His Eminence Cardinal Marc Ouellet. This young lady told him frankly: “*The Army of Mary has taught me to be strong in my moral and spiritual beliefs, to fight against any problems that come my way... Since I have been reading ‘Life of Love’, I have found myself growing spiritually... It has also given me a better understanding of the mission of Mother Paul-Marie.... She is definitely God’s instrument in the present time, knowing full well that she will be denounced by priests and bishops in the end. Everything that she has announced has come to be, in her speaking the truth. What we are left with is a simple choice to either accept or reject her.*”

Then we had Sylvie Payeur-Raynauld’s reflections with regard to His Exc. Archbishop Prendergast’s letters to Mother Paul-Marie: “*[They] leave us quite ill at ease: ‘Beloved Daughter in Christ’... To the compliments are mixed in demands which are equivalent to the putting to death of the Community....*”

The letters of Sister Louise Hélie and Sister Senka addressed to you, Marie-Paule, express their gratitude for “*your love, your abandonment and your pardon*” (Sr. Senka).

“*Through all this Passion which you must live, I pray that you will find along the way a*

few ‘Cyrenians’, a few ‘Veronicas’, a few ‘Johns’ to support you and to remain standing next to you” (Sr. Louise Hélie).
